## **Aimargues**

Start: Parking lot Boulevard Jules Ferry

GPS: 43.686558N / 4.208366E

## Roadmap

Be careful with your children, especially in non-pedestrian areas. The course is carried out under your full responsibility. Randoland and the Tourist Office are not responsible in the event of an accident.

Start the walk on the parking lot of boulevard Jules Ferry. Cross Avenue Jean Moulin to check out the statue ①. Continue on boulevard Saint-Louis then turn left into rue de l'Hotel de ville. Stay to the right to take the rue de la Clastre and then to the left Place du 8 mai 1945. Observe the Georges Brassens hall ②.

Then observe the church **3**.

Then take rue de l'Horloge which runs alongside the Georges Brassens Hall by the left and then directly to the right in rue Pasteur. Back on rue de la Clastre

left side, then again left in rue Roger Bernard then observe the sculpture above the left window of n°11 (4).


Continue, at the crossroads turn left and then take the first street on the right between the houses in the direction of Place Montredun. Go to the right and look at house n°3 (5).

After the house, continue walking on the left in rue Montredon, then turn right and then right again in rue de Baroncelli. Observe the old tower on your left 6.

rue Bollac. Once on Avenue Jean Moulin, turn left to observe the war memorial ?

Then cross Jean Moulin Avenue carefully on the pedestrian crossing and observe the old village washhouse on the opposite side (3).


Return to the parking lot to finish the walk.












# **Aimargues**



#### RIDDLE

anfonne Guillerme, queen of the Camargue, Parisian by birth but Occitan by heart, is the first female manadier. Every 1st Sunday in March, Aimargue organizes a large gathering to pay tribute to this Grand Lady of the "Nacioun gardiano" (the Guardian Nation). This association was founded in the early 1900s by one of his friends. Its purpose is to "maintain and glorify the costume, habits and traditions of the Arles region, of the Camargue and the bullfighting countries". This same friend is also responsible for the creation of the Camargue cross, symbol of the Camargue


