# Le Cailar

## Roadmap

Be careful with your children, especially in non-pedestrian areas. The course is carried out under your full responsibility. Randoland and the Tourist Office are not responsible in the event of an accident.

Start the walk in the parking lot from the playground. Turn right on Boulevard Louis Blanc. Observe the house at n° 12

Continue straight ahead then at the crossing with Avenue Emile Jamais turn left then right on Boulevard Gambetta. Notice the facade of the Laperan hall 2.

Continue on the boulevard and take the second left into Place Ledru Rollin. Observe the church, then turn left into rue Emile Zola 3.


Take the first on the right rue Bernard Lazare then turn left into the Androune (dead end) which passes to the left of number 12. Then turn directly to the right to reach Place Mireille. Then go left, then right to the arenas. Observe the house at number 12 4.

Turn back, continue straight ahead to see the Protestant temple on the right **5**. Turn left on Place André Peyre and then directly to the right to find Boulevard Gambetta. Continue on the boulevard for 400m then cross the Pont du Grès **6**.

After the last one, turn left on Boulevard Michelet. Continue up to the footbridge, cross the river and turn left towards the washhouse 7.

Turn back, continue straight on the Chemen de Masillargues then before the bridge take the left track which runs along the river (8).


Continue on the road for 400m then take the first left towards the churchyard. At the crossroads with the other road, turn right and then left on the road to return to the car park. End of the walk.














This tree is even the origin of a nickname given to the inhabitants.



#### RIDDLE

Cailar is the grazing place for the emblematic Camargue bulls. Among the curiosities of the village there are also tombs of a particular character. Indeed, it is the cocardier bulls that rest there, the population of the village having decided to honour their quality of exceptional bravery during their participation in the Camargue races. The most visible is that of the bull Le Sanglier, the manade Fernand Granon (1920-30), who stands at the entrance to the village. There is another, more discreet one in the meadows.

With the help of the Rando Inspector, will you be able to find out which bull from the list below is being honored ?
