Roadmap

Be careful with your children, especially in non-pedestrian areas. The course is carried out under your full responsibility. Randoland and the Tourist Office are not responsible in the event of an accident.

Start the walk in front of the town hall. Follow the church street and go observe the church **1**.

Then turn left into the street. Look at the inscription on the old bourgeois house with red bricks **2**.

Turn left into Place Silhol-Deveze. Then look for the temple café on your left **3**.

At the roundabout, turn right into Avenue de la Camargue. Then turn left into the route de Générac to go to the school **4**.

Continue straight on to the roundabout

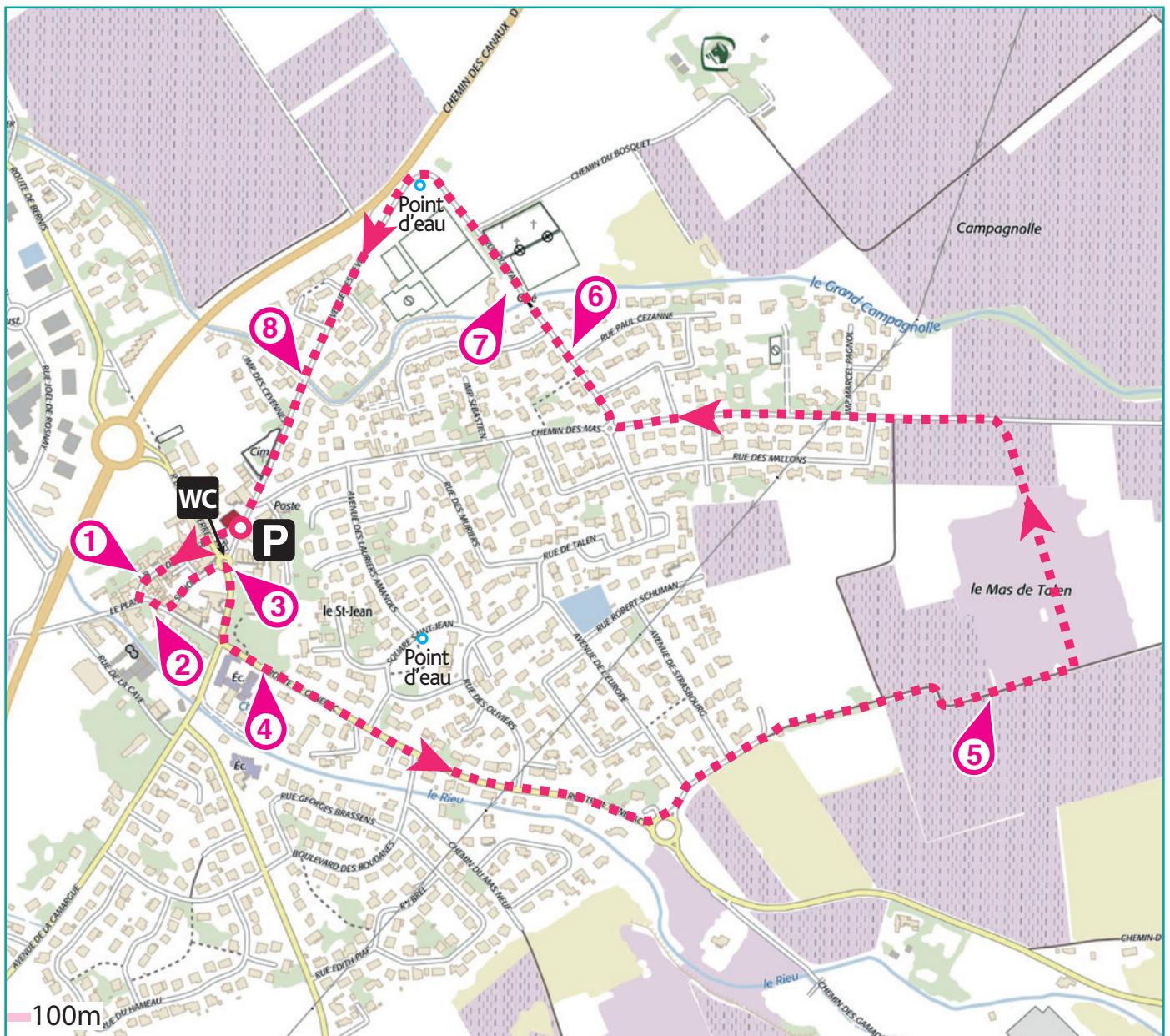
staying on the left side of the road. At the roundabout, turn left then directly right. Continue straight on down the path. After the entrance to the fitness trail, continue for 50 m and cross the olive grove **5**.

At the end of the olive grove, take the path on the right to join the road. On the road, turn left. Continue straight ahead on the road. At the roundabout, turn right into Rue du Stade. Look out for the entrance to No. 5 **6**.

Then go and look at the entrance to the sports complex **7**.

Continue along the road, at the end turn left. Note the scale at the bridge **8**.

Continue straight on to the town hall to finish the walk.

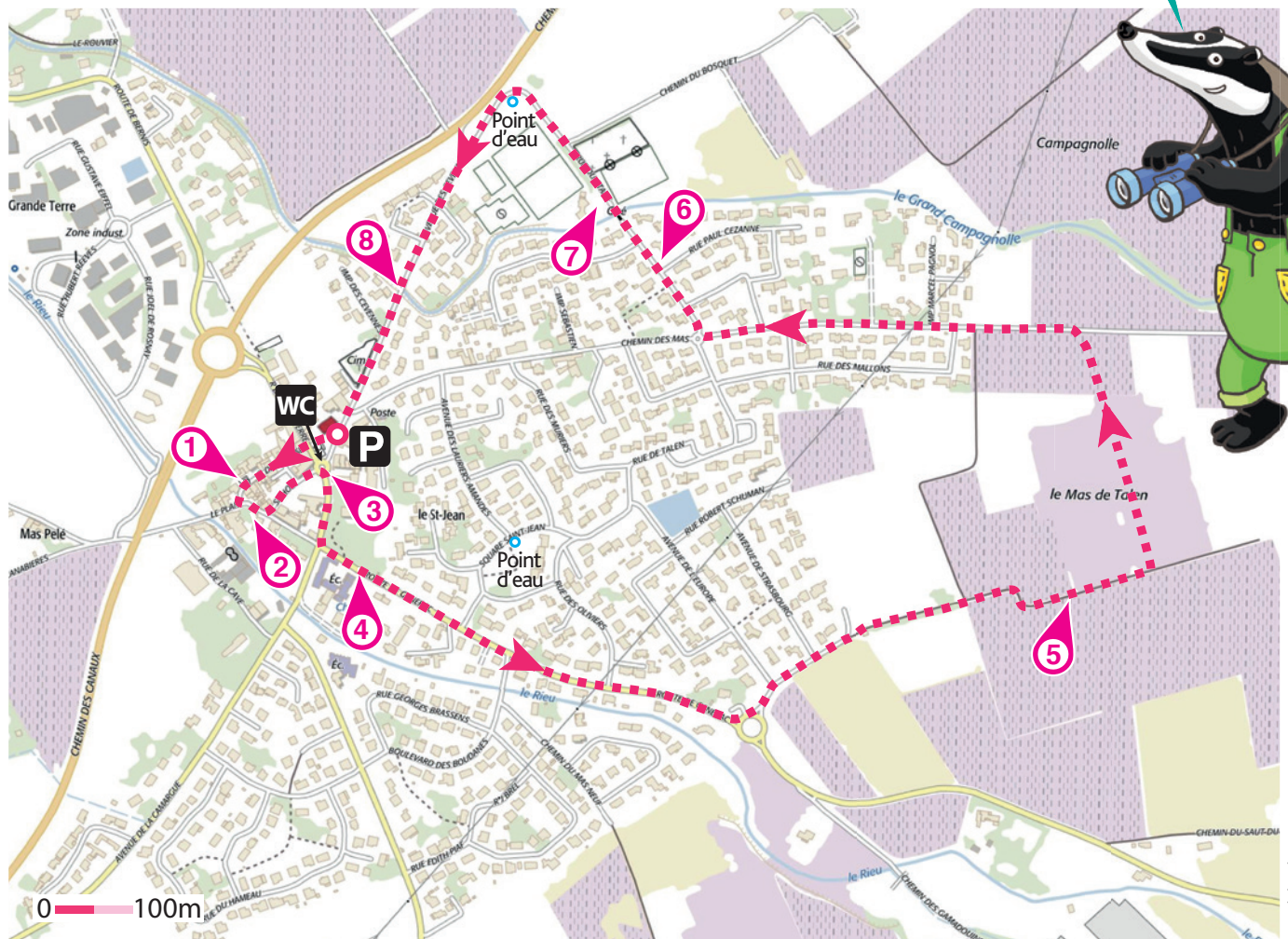
RIDDLE

With Inspector Rando, be her first customer and find out what this famous variety of olive is. Now grown all over the world!

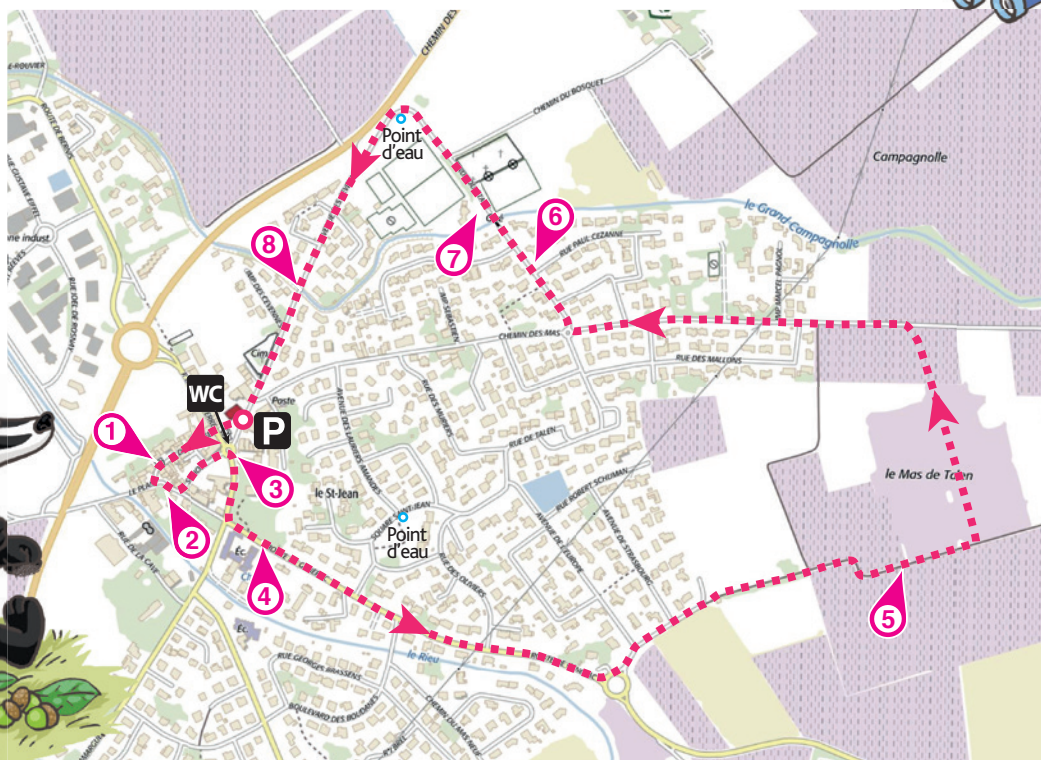

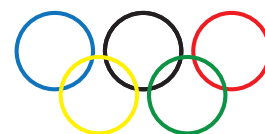
